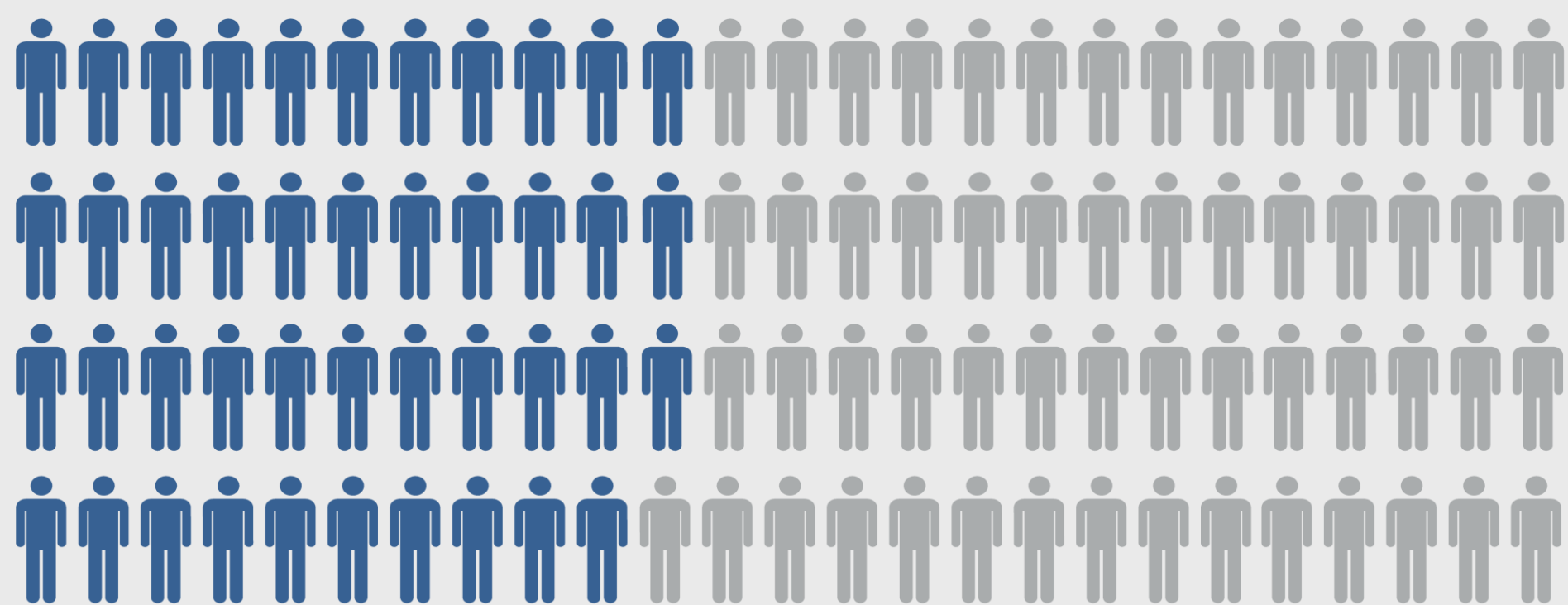

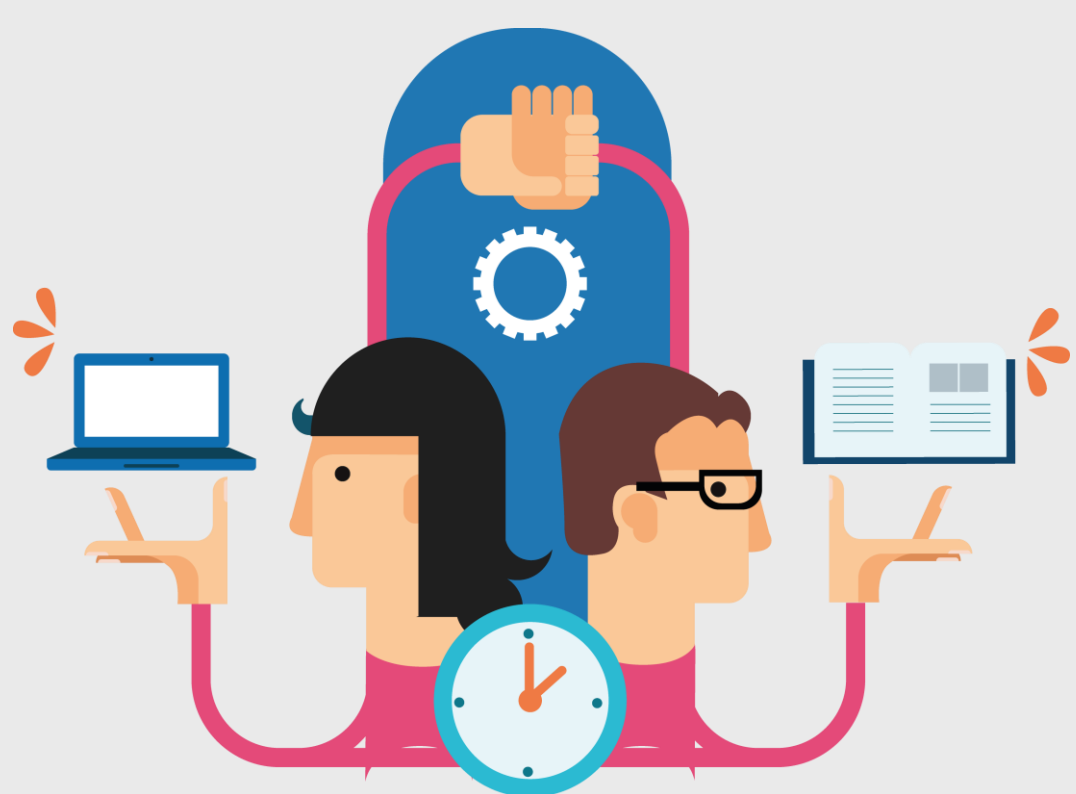
WHY ARE DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES IN EDUCATION IMPORTANT?

43% of Europeans lack basic **digital skills**

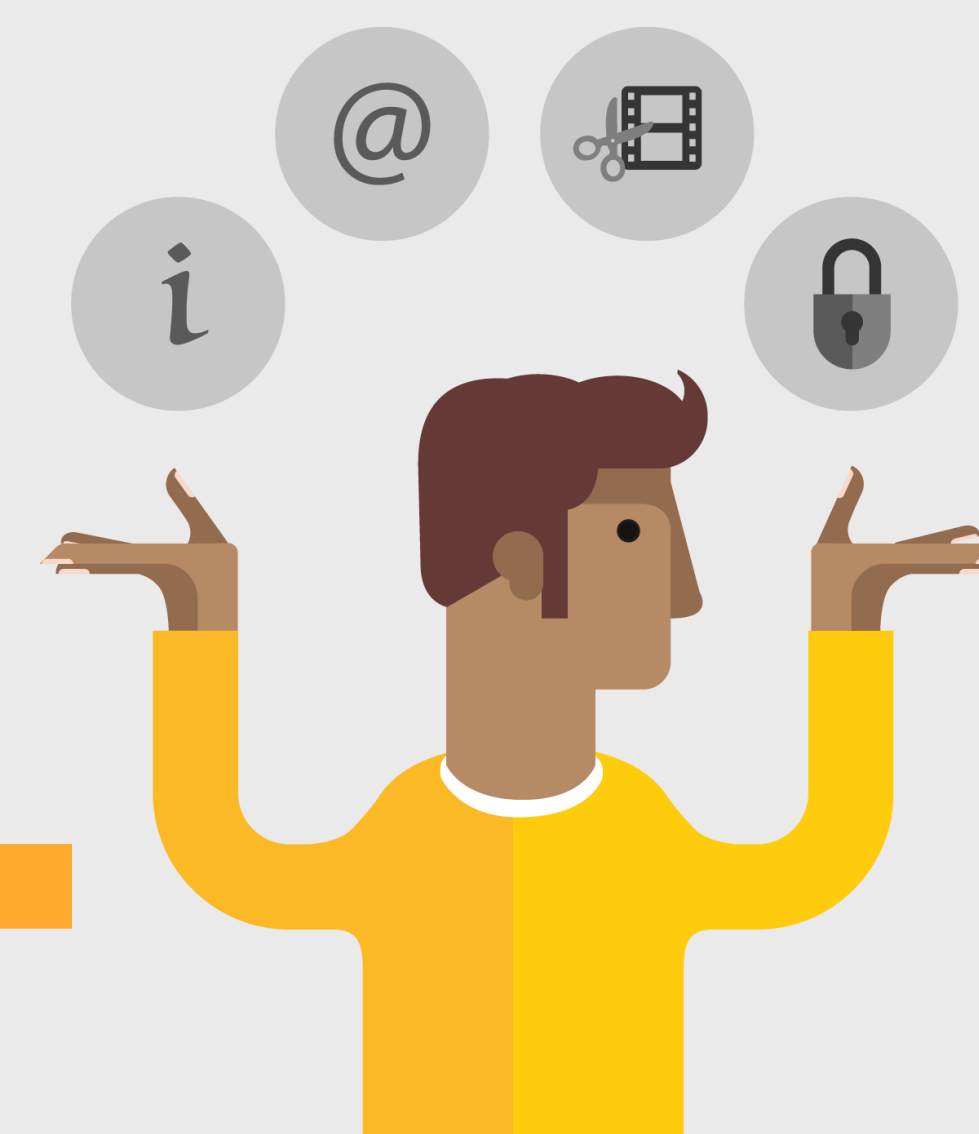


Digital tech is part of our everyday lives, and should be an essential **part of our learning practices**

WHAT IS SELFIE? - HOW DOES SELFIE WORK?

SELFIE **takes a snapshot** of the school's use of digital technology. It's **online** and **anonymous**.



WHAT SELFIE IS NOT

- It does NOT assess schools
- It does NOT compare or benchmark schools
- It is NOT just for digitally-advanced schools: it's for every school

3 questionnaires

"How is technology used in the school?" SELFIE **gathers —anonymously— the views** of students, teachers and school leaders

a tailor-made report

A snapshot of the **school's strengths and weaknesses** in their use of technology for learning

SELFIE looks at **6 key areas of digital education**

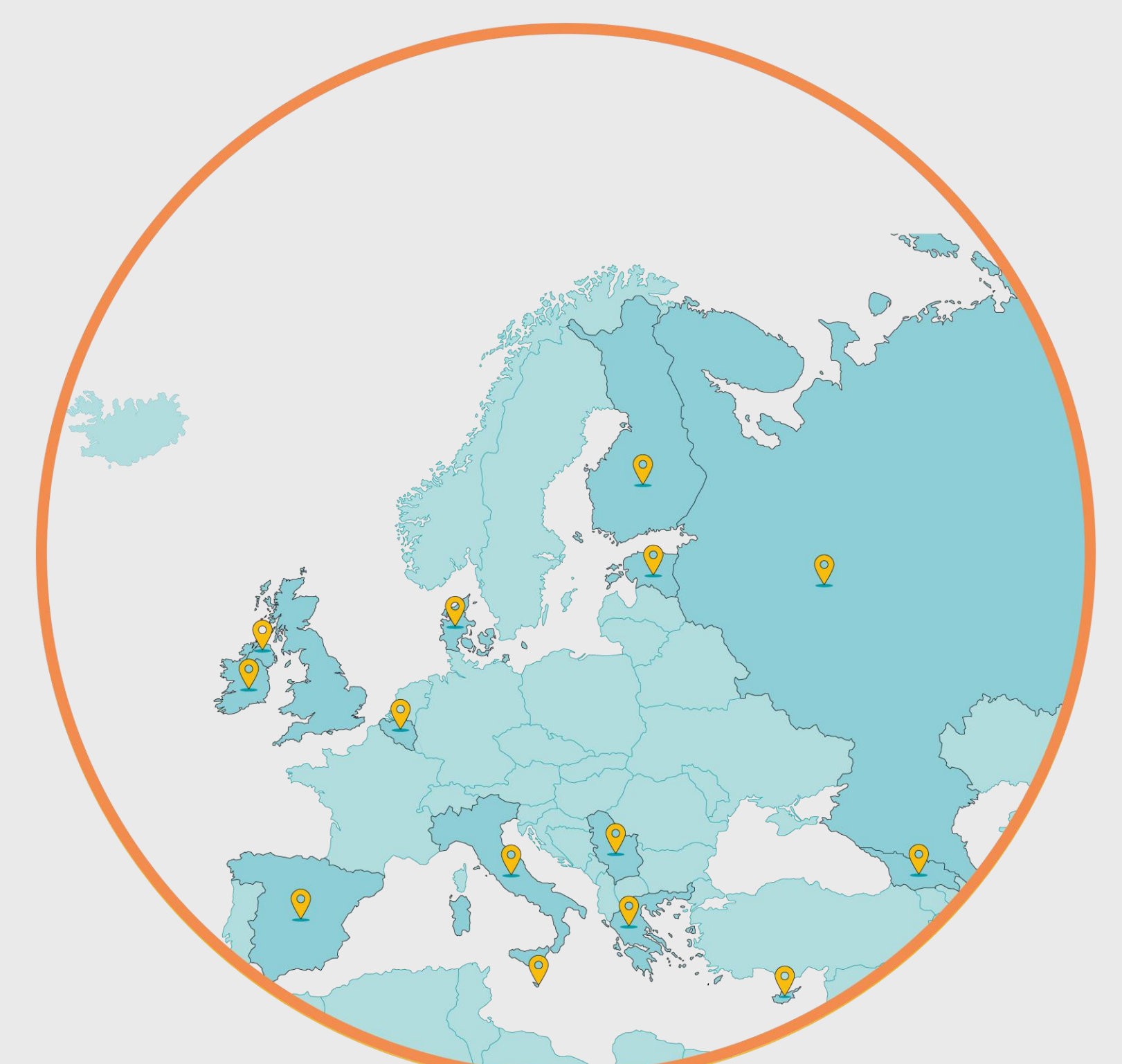
